

Christ United Methodist Church- Trustees Meeting Minutes
April 01, 2019

Those in attendance: Glenn Pearson, Craig Muir, Mike Hilsabeck, Mike Linville, Jeff Portman, Gary Kirkham, Misty Hintz, Carrie McCool, Lauren McCool.

Opening prayer by Misty Hintz.

All attendees introduced themselves.

Minutes from March 04, 2019 meeting were reviewed and approved.

Old business- Emergency lighting test and repair was completed.

Frozen pipe repair in rooms 28 & 29 was completed over spring break.

Duke Energy program to control air conditioning use during hot weather was discussed and conclusion was made that it would not be beneficial to the church to participate in this program.

Riding lawn mower repair will cost about \$850 due to need to repair engine oil leaks.

New business- Lauren McCool presented a plan to expand the playground equipment and area NW of the building. Summer camp activities require additional space and items. It is proposed to install a Gaga pit, Basketball hoop, wooden bench and game painting on the asphalt. Also discussed was the need for additional parking, a picnic-type shelter and a fire pit in the future. Glen will check on a contractor for the excavation work required. Further discussion will be required.

Pastor Kurt asked if he could use church ground for a personal garden. Glen is to check with county extension office on garden plot availability.

A request was received to purchase an engraved brick paver. This program has not been active for several years and it was discussed if and how to renew it. Several local vendors will be checked to see if they can economically engrave the bricks.

Quotes for lawn fertilizer, mulch and trimming were discussed and compared. It was decided to use TruGreen contractor for this work.

Facility usage policy and rate structures for Weddings, Funerals and other events were discussed. Several differing policies are in place now and it was agreed to consolidate these into a single document. This policy and form(s) will be finalized at next month's meeting.
